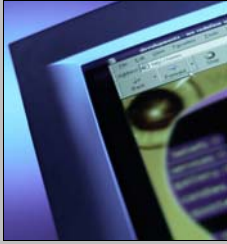


Photography and Digital Design

Description

The Photography and Digital Design program of study introduces students to the field of Multimedia Design and Production through specialization in Digital Photography, Web Design, or the integration of both disciplines. Students explore the photographic process as a method of creative and visual expression while learning skills required for black and white photography, digital photography and imaging. Web Authoring courses equip students to create up-to-date and user-friendly web pages by developing skills in HTML, JavaScript, Flash, and digital imaging. All students will develop a professional portfolio of their work and have opportunity to display selected projects through school and community events.
